Self-Assessment

What your score means

- **7-8** — Strong. Worth a professional review to confirm and close edge cases.
- **4-6** — Average. You have real, fixable gaps that an attacker could find.
- **0-3** — Exposed. Treat this as urgent; the basics are not in place.
